

### **HOW IT WORKS:**

- Complete the order form and send to <u>melannie.eldridge@capitol.nb.ca</u>. You will receive a confirmation with unique promo codes for each requested performance. Do not share codes outside your organization.
- Promo codes do not guarantee tickets they must first be redeemed.

#### TO REDEEM TICKETS:

- Visit <u>capitol.nb.ca</u> and select your performance from the show listing. Click "buy".
- Select an available seat from our floor map. Select the "regular" price category. Select "conclude transaction".
- At the checkout page, locate the box on the lower right that reads "Please apply your member code or promotional code": Enter your unique code and click the green checkmark.
- Select your ticket delivery method. (Note: A fee applies to printed tickets to be mailed. E-tickets are recommended)
- Enter your client information.
- Select "pay". A confirmation message will be sent to your email address.

# **IMPORTANT POLICIES:**

- If you're requesting tickets for a performance that has a special connection with your organization, please indicate on your request form.
- Tickets are first come, first served. Book early to avoid disappointment!
- This program is crafted for nonprofit groups. Requests must be coordinated through nonprofit administrators. Requests from individuals can not be granted.
